## INDIVIDUAL NUMBER CARDS

Have you applied for an Individual Number Card (so-called “My Number Card”)? If so, your card will be sent to the municipal office when it is ready. ## CHILD-REARING ALLOWANCE (JIDO FUYO TEATE)

Child-rearing Allowance is paid in April, August, and December. Check your bank account as the total amount of four months (December – March) allowance will be moved into the account on April 11.

## PAY ATTENTION TO THE DEADLINE FOR TAX PAYMENT

The tax payment notification will be sent to you by mail when the amount of a tax is fixed. You must pay the amount on the statement by the due date. If you have chosen the payment through account transfer, make sure that you have enough money in the registered account.

## **REDUCTION OR EXEMPTION OF PREFECTURAL / MUNICIPAL TAXES**

Bring your tax payment notification of resident tax sent in June and consult Taxation Division of City Hall by 7 days before the payment deadline if you have difficulty in paying the tax due to your losing your job or having a big salary-cut. You may be qualified to have reduction or exemption of prefectural and municipal taxes for the 2018 fiscal year.

## **PENSION : "SPECIAL PAYMENT SYSTEM FOR STUDENTS" APPLY from APRIL**

All residents lives in Japan whose age between 20 to 60 are required to pay naional pension premiums. However, If you are a student and your income is less than a certain amount, you may be allowed to postpone contribution payment if your application is approved.

To use the system, you need to apply your income first.(if your income is more than certain amount, you are not accepted.)

### **○Eligibility**

An enrolled students avobe 20 years old in a University, Post-Graduate Program, Junior College, Technical High School, Vacational School (included Evening/Part time School ,Correspondence Couse, some of the University Japan Branch. Not included any schools in overseas.)

### **○Period of Approval**

From April to March of the following year.(You need to apply for it every year.)

### **○Requierd items.**

- ① Pension book
- ② Student identification card of new school year(copy is ok) or a Certificate of student status.
- ③ Inkan

## VACCINATIONS AND PERIODICAL CHECKUPS



### ○MASS VACCINATIONS

Type	Your Age / Your Child's Birthday	Vaccination Date	Time	
BCG Vaccination	October 1 ~ 10 '18	Tuesday, April 9	13:45~ 14:30	*Contact the Health Center in advance if you would like your child to have the vaccination on a day other than the designated date for him/her. Changes on short notice may be rejected.

## ○INDIVIDUAL VACCINATIONS

The Health center sends a vaccination card to each child at a proper time for each vaccination. Try to take the vaccination shot, with the card and your maternity passbook, as soon as possible after you receive it. Come to the health center with your maternity passbook if you haven't had a card due to your move-in to Konan City or you have lost the card.

<Vaccinations for Babies and Toddlers> DPT-IPV (Diphtheria, Pertussis & Tetanus + Inactivated Polio Vaccine), Polio, MR (Measles & Rubella), JE (Japanese Encephalitis), Hib, Infant Pneumococcus, Chicken Pox

<Vaccinations for School-age Children> DT (Diphtheria & Tetanus), JE (Japanese Encephalitis) \*(special conditions apply)

☆Human Papilloma virus vaccination (against cervical cancer) is not strongly recommended at the moment. If you want your child to take it but don't have a vaccination card for it, come to the center with your maternity passbook to receive one.

※Contact the Health Center if your children have finished Polio vaccination but not completed DPT vaccinations.

※Vaccinations can be received at a designated clinic not only in Konan City but also in Inuyama City, Oguchi Town, or Fuso Town. (Prior appointments are strictly required.)

※Vaccinations could be received in the other city in Aichi Prefecture although conditions apply. (e.g. the children's home doctor is not in Konan, or the babies and their mother have stayed in her home town for a delivery.) Come to the Health Center in advance to arrange the vaccinations out of Konan City.

※The children to take a vaccination should come with their parent / guardian who know their daily health condition well. A letter of proxy from their parent / guardian is required if the other person should come with them. Letter forms are available at the Health Center or downloadable in the city website. ※Contact the Health Center if you want vaccination cards / information sheets for vaccinations translated in Portuguese, English, Chinese, or Spanish.

☆Fluoride Application (at the 18-month / 2.5-year check-ups) is not mandatory. If you want your child to have a fluoride application, make sure to brush their teeth in advance and bring a water bottle to drink fully before applying it, as drinking or eating is not allowed for 30 minutes after the application.
